

## **EUXTON PARISH COUNCIL**

**MINUTES** of an Extra Ordinary Full Council meeting held 1 June 2006 at 7.15 pm in Euxton PC Community Centre, Wigan Road, Euxton.

2. Declarations of Interest

Cllr Dilworth declared an interest in this item and took no part in the meeting or decision.

3. Responses from Greenside Recreation Fields

It was proposed that the shelter be removed from its position at Greenside and a new position and costings be confirmed at the next full council meeting on 15 June.

**Resolved:** Council agreed to suspend standing orders.

Members of the public discussed the problems they encountered at Greenside, some pre-existing and some they felt had increased since the arrival of the shelter.

A representative of Chorley Borough Council attended to ensure residents were aware that the decision to place the shelter on Greenside was not its and read two letters out. It was pointed out that the position was chosen by the Community Safety Team of Chorley Borough Council and a paragraph of the letter stating this was read out.

**Resolved:** Council agreed to restore standing orders.

A Councillor requested a recorded vote.

**Resolved:** Proposed by Cllr Wellerd, seconded by Cllr Jones that the shelter at Greenside be removed for relocation on the James Moorcroft Memorial Play Area, Balshaw Lane and the details be confirmed at the next meeting. Votes for, Cllrs Cocking, Wellerd, M Mercer, Jones, A Mercer; Votes against, Cllrs Sutton, Witts, M Gray, Ashton. The proposal was carried.

There being no further general business the Chairman declared the meeting closed.
