2. **Minutes of Council Meetings**

Resolved: The Committee agreed to follow the recommendation of the report and:

Submit a planning application

Write to Chorley Council to request official permission/tenure of the site

Clerk to follow up on aspects of the proposal to bring back to the Council proposals to consider for the precept request.

4. **Bowling**

Resolved: The Committee agreed to follow the recommendation of the report and:

Gather interested parties from the appeal in the newsletter

Make an official approach and meet with the Cricket Club to secure tenure and arrangements for the land

Investigate if the planning permission is still valid

Gather information from Clayton-le-Woods PC about their recent Green build

6. **Lining Machine**

Resolved: The Committee agreed to purchase a football pitch lining machine at £270 so all teams could use it. Clerk to order.

7. **Millennium Green**

The Clerk updated on the works for the Millennium Green still to be carried out and suggestions for the space left by the tree sculpture when it was felled.

Resolved: The Committee agreed to purchase up to three picnic seat/benches for the Green, preferably from recycled material if the cost is similar or less to the wood ones at £660 for 3. To purchase up to £500 small trees, try Lisieux Hall first. Purchase Blue Bell bulbs.

The Committee recommended to the All Purpose Committee that the Geoff Witts signs should be at the Archway and Car Park, be green and well attached.
