2. Minutes of Council Meetings

Resolved: Leisure Committee minutes of 2 September 2008, were agreed to be accurate record of the meeting and signed by the Chairman.

3. Skatepark

There is to be a Skatepark workshop for young people to input into the design of the skatepark on the 18 March. Following this there may be possibly a second event held with a different design company for the young people.

4. Bowling Green in Euxton

The Clerk has had initial discussions with the Cricket Club about the basics of the land and access and further meeting needs to be arranged to discuss any foreseeable problems such as shared equipment, storage, access etc and try to pull together an agreement.

There needs to be some kind of drawing or artists impression of how the land will look with a green on so it can be shown at a consultation meeting of interested residents. Councillors volunteered to help.

5. Millennium Green

The Clerk updated on the works for the Millennium Green still to be carried and on a new project for a wildflower area which would cost approximately £1500 but a grant of £500 could be applied for from the Green Partnership Awards scheme at LCC.

Resolved: Council agreed for the Clerk to apply for the grant.

6. Greenside pavilion building

Council considered a request from LCC Youth Service to use the building for meeting young people/doing future projects in.

Resolved: Council agreed to the idea in principle, the Clerk to confirm the level of supervision and inform it would be reviewed after 6 months.

7. Any Other Business

The Clerk informed the Committee of an issue which has arisen from the United Utilities new billing system and distributed the information. This item would be brought to the Full Council's attention next week at which point the Clerk should have some quotations for alternatives.
