2. Minutes of last Meeting

Resolved: Minutes of the All Purposes Committee held 4 July 2019 were agreed to be accurate record of the meeting.

3. Updates on current and finished projects, verbal

The Pavement Blockages initiative was discussed, the newsletter articles and feedback. BW mentioned some specific areas, one being the walk from Cedar Avenue and down to Packsaddle bridge. The lack of crossing points and dropped kerbs.

A project to identify specific improvements, such as dropped kerbs, on the route from Primrose Hill School to Packsaddle Bridge are to be mapped and proposed to LCC, including info from the School and new Nursery about increased pedestrian traffic and, to include information about the new houses on the former Railway pub site.

4. Flower displays – update on all the items, consider new projects

Members discussed the displays for this year. Three 1m square tubs will be ordered/purchased for the island on Euxton Lane. 4 barrier baskets were suggested on railings or crossing, opposite the Talbot pub, as they are set back from the road.

A living/growing Christmas Tree was suggested to be planted at the site on Southport Road, skate side, which in future might be lit when it grows to a decent height.

Cordylines in planter on Washington Lane corner need adjusting.

The Heritage listings was raised, Clerk is waiting on locations/descriptions for the forms.
