4. Consultation from LCC regarding parking restrictions at Greenside

LCC consultation on the prohibition of waiting/loading/parking between March 2020 and August 2020, with plan

Consultation arrived from LCC via email on 27/02/20 10.47

Circulated to Parish Councillors via email 27/02/20 15.56 and posted on Council's Facebook and Website

EPC emailed LCC 27/02/20 to ask them to make the notice clearer (due to the confusion over using words which match street names ie, North side and South side) and, to clarify that prohibition of waiting/loading is in fact a full ban on all types of parking and for the whole 24hrs a day from March 20 to August 21. Confirmed.

LCC update 28/02/20

I have been in discussion with Westchurch Homes Ltd covering all issues raised and it has been identified that we are able to place one disability parking bay within the 18m free space between properties 203 to 209, I am awaiting a detailed plan of the exact appropriate location and will re-send the Initial Notification when in receipt of the details.

The disabled bay will not be allocated to one particular resident however it will be available for any person with mobility issues.

Councillors responses from the email 27/02/20, so far to 28/02/20 17.45

- ...timings are not appropriate
- ...the blanket prohibition throughout the period specified is excessive and should only apply during the hours allowed for building. Residents should not be further inconvenienced when building is not taking place.
- It would be more acceptable if time limits were included. For example the order is for Monday to Friday 9am to 4pm. I dont see any need outside of these hours as the site as I understand it, have strict delivery times and they do not normally work weekends.
- Don't agree with no parking at all any time day or night, could it not just been restricted during working hours, say 8.30 to 5.30 at most, Monday to Friday only.
- I agree that the restriction is necessary, but also agree that the way it is written is anything but clear.

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING) ORDER 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council intend to make an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit the waiting and loading of vehicles as described below.

1. Prohibition of Waiting and Prohibition of Loading at any time and on any day:-
 - I. Greenside, Euxton - North side - From a point 26 metres south-east of its junction with the centreline of Woodside, for a distance of 18 metres in a south-westerly direction
 - II. Greenside, Euxton – North side - From a point 26 metres south-east and 52 metres south-west of its junction with the centreline of Woodside, for a distance of 6.5 metres in a south-westerly direction
 - III. Greenside, Euxton - South side – from a point 26 metres south-east of its junction with the centreline of Woodside, for a distance of 58.5 metres in a south-westerly direction
2. The prohibition will be operative from 0700 hours on Monday 23rd March 2020 until 1730 hours on Friday 27th August 2021 or until completion of the works within this period.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Westchurch Homes Ltd safe access for vehicles carrying out works on the new development.


