1. Apologies - Cllr Parr
2. Minutes of meeting 3 July 2014

Resolved: Leisure Committee minutes of 3 July 2014, were agreed to be accurate record of the meeting and signed by the Chairman.

10. Balshaw Lane Ponds Project

Resolved: Leisure Committee agreed with the report and to recommend to Council the budget be increased to £7,000.

3. Balshaw Lane play area toddler park

Resolved: Leisure Committee agreed to recommend to Full Council precept to budget for a further £10,000 for the toddler park.

4. Primrose resident

The Committee considered the suggestion of a resident to construct a cover over the kick about area at Primrose, similar to a multi use games area. There have been no reports or problems from any other residents in the area, a covered area type facility would need LCC, school and planning permission and cost upwards of £70K. Clerk to write to resident to inform that Council had considered the suggestion.

5. Greenside disabled and Greenside rail queries from residents

The Committee considered both these suggestions from residents. Clerk to update via letter. CCH will be removing the hedge next to the path soon and following this the gate and access will be reconsidered when we know what the new layout looks like. The rail suggestion will be passed to Lancashire Highways as it is their realm.

6. Greenside hedge removal

The Committee considered this request from Chorley Community House. There was no objection to the hedge removal and the Council cutting the extra strip of grass.

7. Pavilion EGFC food

The Committee considered the issue of cooking in the pavilion. The team had not requested permission in light of the terms of the agreement, particularly 6, 8 and 12. Clerk to write and inform that they must get permission but also ask questions about how they are cooking, on what, a copy of the food inspection, equipment to be tested, clarification about insurance etc. They should cease cooking food until this is done.

8. Safety humps at Skate Park

The Committee received information about Chorley Council's suggested safety/speed humps at the entrance to the skate park.

9. Request from ECC for a noticeboard/sign

The Committee considered the information but would need a design/spec to be able to consider in full. If Council were to agree to a board, it would also need CBC permission as EPC lease the land from Chorley.

There being no further general business the Chairman declared the meeting closed.
