<p>1. Employment, office, trade, profession or vocation:                  Any employment, office, trade, profession or vocation carried on for profit or gain.  <i>Example</i> The name and address of your employer and your role in that company. <u>N/A</u></p>
<p>2. Sponsorship: Any payment or provision of any other financial benefit (other than from the relevant authority) made or provided within the relevant period in respect of any expenses incurred by M in carrying out duties as a member, or towards the election expenses of M. <u>N/A</u></p>
<p>3. Contracts: Any contract which is made between the relevant person (or a body in which the relevant person has a beneficial interest) and the relevant authority:                  (a) under which goods or services are to be provided or works are to be executed; and                  (b) which has not been fully discharged. <u>N/A</u></p>
<p>4. Land: Any beneficial interest in land which is within the area of the relevant authority.                  Example <b>Your home address</b>. Do not leave box empty.</p>
<p>Licences: Any licence (alone or jointly with others) to occupy land in the area of the relevant authority for a month or longer. <u>N/A</u></p>
<p>Corporate tenancies: Any tenancy where (to M's knowledge):                  (a) the landlord is the relevant authority; and                  (b) the tenant is a body in which the relevant person has a beneficial interest. <u>N/A</u></p>
<p>Securities: Any beneficial interest in securities of a body where:                  (a) that body (to M's knowledge) has a place of business or land in the area of the relevant authority; and                  (b) either:                  (i) the total nominal value of the securities exceeds £25,000 or one hundredth of the total issued share capital of that body; or                  (ii) if the share capital of that body is of more than one class, the total nominal value of the shares of any one class in which the relevant person has a beneficial interest exceeds one hundredth of the total issued share capital of that class. <u>N/A</u></p>

- Any gifts or hospitality must be registered within 28 days of receiving it.
